Subject: Revision of Guidelines of National Awards to Teachers.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite reference of video conference held on 20.06.2018 by Special Secretary (SE), D/o School Education and Literacy, Govt. of India, New Delhi wherein the following points have been reiterated:

1. Regarding teaching experience of regular School Teachers and Heads of Schools working in recognized primary/middle/high/higher secondary schools, it was clarified that there is no prescribed minimum number of years of teaching experience required for the Award.
2. Educational Administrators, Inspectors of Education, and the staff of training Institutes are not eligible for these awards and only regular teachers and heads of schools are eligible for the awards.
3. It was clarified that Chief Education Officer (CEO) will be the Chairperson of District Selection Committee in place of DEO wherever applicable.
4. State Govt. should only give nominations for State Govt./aided/local body schools. They need not nominate for CBSE awards.
